ITINERARY

Day 01:: Arrival in Kathmandu, Overnight at Hotel

If it's a clear day when you are flying into Kathmandu, then your tour begins right from the skies itself. The sights from the windows of our jet show us glimmering snow-capped mountain peaks spread out down below us, giving us the first thrills of our just begun vacation, sparking off a whole reaction of unforgettable experiences that stay with us for some time to come. As soon as your plane hits the tarmac of Tribhuvan International Airport, Mountain Sherpa Trekking & Expeditions office representative and driver will be on standby to meet and greet you at the airport and escort you to your hotel. The rep will help you check into your designated hotel, and after going to our rooms and refreshing ourselves we will be briefed about our daily activities. The rest of your time is free to move around the neighborhood and get familiar with your surroundings. Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 02:: Full day Sightseeing in Kathmandu: 4 major tourist places- Overnight stay at Hotel (B)

After a good night's sleep and enjoying a hearty b/fast, we proceed for our tour of Basantapur Durbar Square. Recorded by UNESCO as a cultural World Heritage site, Kathmandu Durbar Square is a bunch of medieval temples, palaces, courtyards and streets that date back to the 12th and 18th centuries. within this square we will find Hanumandhoka Palace Museum, Taleju Temple, Kumari Ghar (House of the Living Goddess), Kasthamandap and other temples and buildings as old as the city itself; from here we head for a tour of the famous Boudhanath Stupa {said to be the largest in the world} and a major centre of Tibetan culture in Kathmandu. The stupa is designed to be like a giant mandala (a representation of the Buddhist cosmos).

We next drive down to Swayambhunath {popularly known as Monkey Temple} "Swayambhu" means "self-created" and refers to the myth that the hill sprung up suddenly from a great lake that once covered Kathmandu Valley. We then drive down to the domestic airport for our flight to Chitwan for our Jungle Safari outing. Breakfast

Day 03:: Drive to Pokhara- Transfer to Hotel



After a hearty breakfast; we board our tourist coach at 7 am in the morning and proceed towards Pokhara, which is 200 km away from Kathmandu. On reaching Pokhara, we check in to our designated hotel, refresh, and get familiar with our surroundings. Later in the evening we can go for a romantic stroll down by the serene Fewa Lake. Overnight at your hotel in Pokhara down by the lake - breakfast

Day 04:: Full day sightseeing tour in Pokhara city. Overnight stay at Hotel

After a warm breakfast, we then proceed for a full day guided tour that will include visiting some beautiful places like David's waterfall, Tibetan refugee settlement camp and Gupteshwar cave in a private vehicle with a professional guide. Our tour also includes an early drive down to the vantage point of Sarangkot for an awesome sunrise over the famous peaks of Fishtail [Machhapucharre] and the Annapurna Mountains. This is an unforgettable experience where we take out a lot of pictures. After enjoying Sarangkot to the hilt, we drive back to our hotel for breakfast and then do some boating on the Fewa Lake and visit the Barahi temple in the center of the lovely lake. Overnight at our hotel - Breakfast

Day 05:: Drive to Chitwan

After our breakfast, it's a scenic drive down to the highway to Chitwan for our Jungle Safari outing. On reaching our Chitwan and our Jungle safari camp, we check into our rooms and the lodge manager gives us an orientation on the history of the camp and briefs us about our program. We then have lunch and proceed for a stroll in the park. Overnight at our jungle Resort - L. D

Day 06:: Full day activities in Chitwan- Overnight Stay at resort.

After a good night's rest, we get up after being well rested, enjoy breakfast amidst the chattering of birds that always tend to sweetly wake us up first thing in the morning during all the time we spend at the safari resort. It's a Full day of Jungle activities in the National Park. We begin with an Elephant-back Safari that extends to a canoe-excursion to view varieties of wildlife. It's almost certain the Rhino will be seen and there is always a chance of seeing a yawning tiger relaxed under the shades of a tree. The park has a real buzzing bird life and even in winter, it's likely to get quite warm. We also get to see crocs lazing around in the sunshine on the banks of the river. B. L. D

Day 07:: Drive to Kathmandu by bus & Transfer to Nagarkot by Car

After a good night's rest in the jungle, we get up for breakfast, laze around a bit at the park and then head down the highway for a cool drive to Kathmandu. On reaching Kathmandu, we refresh at Thamel and then in the late afternoon, drive down to the scenic resort hideout of Nagarkot. We'll be in time to view a great sunset from the tower at twilight. Overnight at the tranquil hill resort of Nagarkot - Breakfast

Day 08:: Drive to Airport for departure to Home

We wake up early to enjoy a great and fascinating sunrise after which, we return back to our hotel for breakfast. We then drive down to Kathmandu to connect with our flight home. **Our Guide and office vehicle will be on standby at your hotel to transfer you to the airport for your connecting flight home.
