The path winds alongside the Dudh Koshi River valley, offering stunning views. Our journey continues, gently ascending to the village of Ghat (2530m) before reaching our final destination for the day, the welcoming village of Phakding.

Here in Phakding, you can relax and recharge for the adventures that lie ahead. Your stay includes all meals, allowing you to savor the flavors of the region and prepare for the next leg of your remarkable journey. Rest well, as we have more exciting experiences awaiting us on the morrow.

Day 04:: Trek to Namche Bazaar (3440M) - Approx. Trek 6 hrs.

After a hearty breakfast, our journey takes us through the enchanting pine forest, leading us alongside the Dudh Koshi River. Along the way, we'll traverse numerous suspension bridges and pass through Sherpa settlements like Benkar, Manjo, and Jorsale. As you continue your ascent, you'll be treated to glimpses of the serene Mt. Thamserku (6618 m) after crossing the check post.

The path then follows the riverbed of Dudh Koshi to the confluence of the Bhote Koshi and Dudh Koshi rivers, offering a breathtaking view of Mt. Everest and the Nuptse-Lhotse ridge that will leave you in awe. After about a 3-hour ascent through the captivating pine forest, we'll finally arrive at the prosperous trading and administrative hub of Namche Bazaar.

Here in Namche Bazaar, you'll rest for the night at a cozy lodge, surrounded by the stunning Himalayan landscape. Your adventure is just beginning, and the wonders of the region will continue to captivate you. Enjoy a well-deserved rest and recharge for the days to come.

Day 05:: Acclimatization/rest day at Namche - Approx. hike 3 hrs.

Today, in the vibrant hub of Namche Bazaar, we take a vital pause to acclimatize ourselves to the high altitude of 3,440 meters (11,286 feet). As seasoned Sherpa experts, we strongly recommend spending two nights in Namche Bazaar to allow your body to adjust effectively before proceeding to Tengboche.

After a nourishing breakfast, our experienced Sherpa guide will lead you on an exhilarating day hike that takes you even higher above Namche Bazaar. This day's adventure will introduce you to two of the most picturesque Sherpa villages, **Khunde (3,840 meters or 12,598 feet)** and **Khumjung (3,790 meters or 12,434 feet)**. As you ascend, you'll have the chance to visit the world's highest-located hotel, where you can savor a cup of coffee or tea while gazing at the mesmerizing beauty of Mt. Everest. The view also encompasses the majestic Ama Dablam, Thamserku, Khaantaiga, and the surrounding wonders of the Khumbu Valley.

In the afternoon, we'll return to our lodge for a rejuvenating hot shower and some well-deserved refreshment. You can relish a hot and hearty meal in the evening, ensuring you're energized and prepared for the incredible journey that lies ahead. Acclimatization is a crucial step, and our experienced team is dedicated to your safety and comfort. Enjoy this day of exploration, and get ready for more unforgettable experiences on the horizon.

Day 06:: Trek to Tengboche Monastery (3860M) - Approx. hike 4-5 hrs.

Today, after a satisfying breakfast, we embark on our trek. The trail begins fairly flat, offering breathtaking vistas of some of the world's most renowned peaks, including Mt. Everest, Ama Dablam, Nuptse, and Lhotse, while granting us up-close encounters with Thamsferku and Khangtaiga.

As we continue, we may be fortunate enough to spot the region's wildlife, such as musk deer and vibrant pheasants. The trail gradually descends to the banks of the Dudh Koshi River, where a mesmerizing chain of prayer wheels awaits. Crossing the river via a bridge, we face a challenging ascent through fragrant pine and juniper forests, ultimately leading us to Tengboche.

As we reach Tengboche, the backdrop is adorned with the grandeur of Ama Dablam, Nupte, Mt. Everest, and a multitude of other majestic peaks. Here, the renowned Gomba, or Tengboche Monastery, comes into view, adding to the cultural and natural marvels of this journey.

Tonight, we'll rest in a comfortable lodge, surrounded by these remarkable landscapes. All your meals are included, ensuring you have the sustenance needed for the adventure at this elevation. Tengboche, situated at approximately 3,870 meters (12,697 feet), is a significant point on your journey.

Tengboche is indeed one of the best viewpoints for Mt. Everest, offering a spectacular and unobstructed view of the world's highest peak. While gazing at Mt. Everest from Tengboche, you can also feast your eyes on several other stunning mountains in the region. Some of the prominent peaks visible from Tengboche include Ama Dablam, Nuptse, Lhotse, Thamsferku, and many more, making it a panoramic paradise for mountain enthusiasts.

Day 07:: Trek to Manjo (2800M) - Approx. Trek 6-7 hrs.

The trek from **Tengboche to Manjo** is a scenic journey in Nepal's Khumbu region. After witnessing a stunning sunrise over the Himalayas and having breakfast, you'll start your descent from Tengboche through lush forests of rhododendron and pine trees, with breathtaking views of Ama Dablam and other peaks.

The trail leads you to Namche Bazaar, a bustling Sherpa town and trading hub with plenty of places to rest and refuel. You'll cross several exhilarating suspension bridges over the Dudh Koshi River, offering stunning river and landscape views.

Passing through charming Sherpa villages like Jorsalle, you'll have opportunities to interact with locals and experience their way of life. The trail closely follows the banks of the Dudh Koshi River, creating a serene and spiritual atmosphere with prayer wheels and mani stones.

After a day of trekking, you'll arrive in Manjo, a peaceful village in the heart of the Khumbu region, where you can rest and enjoy the tranquility. The trek involves an elevation descent from Tengboche (3,870 meters) to Manjo (2,835 meters). The distance is approximately 10-12 kilometers, and it takes 6-7 hours, depending on your pace and stops.

This journey offers a mix of natural beauty, cultural experiences, and a glimpse into the daily life of the Sherpa people.

Day 08:: Trek to Lukla- Approx. hike 4 hrs.

After a nourishing breakfast, we commence our trek from the tranquil village of Manjo, nestled in the Khumbu region. Manjo sits at an altitude of approximately 2,835 meters (9,300 feet), while Lukla, our destination, is situated at about 2,800 meters (9,186 feet). This leg of our journey involves a gentle descent, providing a more leisurely walking experience.

The distance from Manjo to Lukla spans roughly 6-8 kilometers (3.7-5 miles), and typically takes around 4-5 hours to complete, depending on our pace and any stops we make along the way. The trail leads us through a lush, forested area, surrounded by serene greenery.

As we trek, we'll pass through charming villages like Phakding, Chumoa, and Chheplung, granting us insights into the local culture and the chance to connect with the welcoming residents. Approaching Lukla, a sense of achievement washes over us as we reach the gateway to the Everest region. Lukla is a bustling town and the central hub for flights to and from Kathmandu.

Our journey culminates in **Lukla**, where we can unwind, celebrate our accomplishments, and prepare for our flight back to Kathmandu.

breakfast, we set out on a full day of exploration in Pokhara. During our sightseeing tour, we visit the following sites:

Davis Fall: Known locally as Patale Chhango, this natural wonder is located in the southern part of the Pokhara valley. It's where the water from Fewa Lake cascades down a rock face into a deep gorge, creating a series of mesmerizing waterfalls. This site is immensely popular with both tourists and locals.

Gupteshwor Cave: Situated just 2 kilometers from Pokhara airport and across from Davis Fall, this revered cave stretches almost 3 kilometers in length. It features spacious hall-sized chambers and some passages where you may need to crawl on all fours. Of special significance to Hindus, the cave houses a preserved phallic symbol of Lord Shiva in the same condition as when it was discovered.

Tibetan Refugee Camps: The Tibetan villages of Tashiling in the south and Tashi Palkhel in the north of Pokhara are well-known for their production and trade of woolen carpets and various handicrafts. The original Tibetan settlers arrived in this region in 1959-60.

Mountain Museum: The International Mountain Museum in Pokhara boasts a remarkable collection of artifacts, original mountaineering gear, stories, and photographs related to the mountains and their inhabitants.

This day of exploration promises a rich blend of natural wonders, cultural experiences, and historical insights, providing a deeper appreciation of the Pokhara region.

We'll then continue our rafting journey for another 2 hours, navigating through exciting rapids with names like TWIN ROCK, LADIES DELIGHT, UPSET, and SURPRISE.
